

Your Wellness Eye Exam

A Wellness Visit is your annual, “I’ve got no problems with my eye”, preventive, “routine” eye examination. (emphasis on preventive)

- At today’s visit, we will review your health history, issues that run in your family, and address preventive care, as well as verify that your eyeglass prescription is relatively the same. In a sense, we are looking for early signs of any eye disease, just like your annual physical at your Primary Care Physician’s office.

Your Wellness Eye Examination includes:

- Review of Systems
- Review of Social Factors
- Review of Ocular and Systemic History
- Review of Medications & their Effects on Vision
- Detection of Risk Factors for Eye Disease
- Visual System Health Status Evaluation
- Refractive Status Evaluation

Some patients save up a list of problems for their wellness exam.

Unfortunately a wellness exam is not the appropriate time to deal with problems.

- Good news: If any medical care can be done during a wellness exam, it will be billed separately from the wellness exam and other charges or deductibles may apply.
- Bad news: Some medical testing cannot be performed the same day as a wellness exam (per insurance guidelines) and will require you to return on another day.

Please note: If you have been diagnosed with an eye condition of any kind in the past, checking that condition will be vital to your health and will be billed under your medical coverage.
